

**Newell Public Library  
Roku/Amazon Fire Stick Policy**

The Newell Public Library has a Roku & Amazon Fire Streaming Stick for patrons to use. These are sticks that plug into a TV's HDMI port, turning the television into a smart device. You can stream movies, shows, and educational content from a wide range of sources.

A television with HDMI port and WIFI are needed for these.

**Eligibility:**

- These must be checked out to a Newell Public Library card holder who is 18 years of age or older and their account is up to date.
- Children should only use the streaming sticks under adult supervision.

**Loan Period:**

- Limited to 1 streaming stick per household.
- The checkout period is 14 days with 0 renewals.
- Reservations are available upon request. Please call ahead to reserve.
- **Borrowers must return these in the library ONLY, do not put them in the dropbox, as this could damage them.**

**Fines & Liability:**

- The overdue fine is \$1 per day. The maximum overdue charge is \$10. Once it reaches this point, steps will be taken to return the items. See "Circulation Policy" for more information on this. Steps will be taken sooner if there is a reservation on hold.
- Borrowers must return the streaming sticks and all accompanying materials in good condition. The library will assess the cost to replace onto the patron's account if lost or damaged beyond repair.

- Borrowers may not download or remove any titles, apps, accounts or content from the devices. They are preloaded with selected accounts and content, in accordance with the library collection development policy. Please see \*Content for more information

- The Library is not responsible for any loss of data that may occur due to malfunctioning hardware or software.
